Casa Latina is a social justice organization, supporting Latino immigrant employment rights and working towards more equitable living and working conditions. Leverage your skills in event planning, networking, and program management by serving as our next **Volunteer Specialist**.

We seek an experienced professional to become our **next Volunteer Specialist**. The Volunteer Specialist serves as the point of contact between all volunteers and the robust programmatic needs within the organization. The Volunteer Specialist engages, supports and guides volunteers to ensure a mutually beneficial relationship between the volunteers and needs of the organization. This is a **part-time position** that reports to the Education Coordinator.



Our ideal candidate is eager to meet new people and welcome individuals into the work of a social-justice organization; is highly adaptive and willing to learn from new and challenging situations; can productively collaborate with others while bringing creative, solution-oriented ideas forward; and is motivated to be part of an important social movement that empowers the Latino community to participate more fully in the economy and democracy of this country.

As Volunteer Specialist, you will:

- Serve as first point of contact and connect prospective volunteers and interns with the appropriate Casa Latina programs.
- Provide adequate orientation, training and support for volunteers and interns on an ongoing basis.
- Work directly with Casa Latina program coordinators to support growing program needs.
- Establish and maintain partnerships with local schools, faith communities, service organizations, and businesses that connect Casa Latina with potential volunteers.
- Collaborate with Casa Latina's resource development department in identifying and cultivating volunteers as potential donors to Casa Latina.

- Work with the development department to support volunteer participation in fundraising efforts. Play a key role the major annual fundraising event.
- Coordinate Volunteer recognition and training events.
- Plan and oversee special service events.
- Other similar functions as assigned.

At Casa Latina, you will be part of a collaborative work environment and warm community atmosphere. The program participants and people you serve are on-site, where you can see the impact of your work every day. We own a three-building campus, conveniently located in Seattle's historic Central District with excellent public transportation options and free parking.

Desired Qualifications:

- At least two years' experience supervising and/or coordinating volunteers or related management experience.
- Strong administrative and organizational skills that reflect ability to perform and prioritize multiple tasks with excellent attention to detail.
- Very strong interpersonal skills and the ability to build relationships with stakeholders including workers, staff, board, external partners, and donors.
- Flexible and able to work independently, take initiative, and prioritize.
- Knowledge of social justice and the immigration and labor movements.
- Bilingual Spanish-English.
- Must have a positive attitude and the ability to work well with diverse groups of people.
- Advanced skills in Microsoft Office programs including Outlook, Excel, Word and SharePoint, as well as Google Docs.
- Familiarity with Blackbaud products, such as eTapestry, a plus.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills in English.
- Ability to grow and structure volunteer positions based upon the changing needs of Casa Latina.
- Strong sense of initiative, vision and resourcefulness.

Compensation: Between \$21.22 to \$22.29 per hour depending on experience. This is a part-time, non-exempt position regularly scheduled to work approximately 20 hours a week, with opportunities for additional hours for special events and programs. This position is part of the staff bargaining unit represented by OPEIU Local 8. Generous benefits, including paid vacation, medical, dental, and retirement. (Retirement plan begins after one year of employment.)
